Factsheet and Rules for ASDAR Scholarships

1. ASDAR will award two \$1,500 scholarships in March, 2024.
2. All applicants must be Alabama residents. Only seniors graduating from an accredited high school or home school program are eligible. Applicants must plan to attend an accredited college or university in the State of Alabama, or if the chosen course of study is not offered within the State of Alabama, plan to attend an out-of-state college or university under the Common Market Proviso.
3. Applicants must be a U.S. citizen and provide proof of citizenship as described on the checklist and application form.
4. ASDAR scholarship applications and checklist may be accessed on the ASDAR website and must be sent directly to the ASDAR Scholarship chairman. All required forms, recommendations and other information listed on the application form must be returned in one package. All applications must be **received** by ASDAR Scholarship Committee Chair by January 5th. Only applications completed correctly, submitted in one package and received by the deadline will be considered.
5. Applications will be judged on the basis of academic merit, character, work habits, potential, school related and community activities, and financial need. Scholarships are judged and awarded without regard to gender, race, color, religion, national origin or disability. **Personal photographs will result in disqualification and should not be submitted.**
6. Student photographs on high school transcripts must be covered or obscured, otherwise the application will be disqualified.
7. In order to ensure equitable assessment of an applicant's financial need, the financial need form must contain sufficient information to illustrate the applicant's need for financial assistance. Lack of sufficient information about the applicant's family financial situation may negatively impact consideration of the application.
8. Funds awarded must be used for educational purposes only and not for personal expenses.
9. No relationship with a DAR member is necessary to qualify for an ASDAR scholarship.
10. Only applications for Alabama Society DAR Scholarships should be sent to the ASDAR Scholarship Committee Chairman. **All applications for National Society DAR Scholarships must be submitted on NSDAR forms to the NSDAR Scholarship Chairman in accordance with the directions on those forms.**

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CHECKLIST AND APPLICATION FOR ASDAR SCHOLARSHIPS**

INSTRUCTIONS: The application must be complete and arranged in the order listed below. ALL items listed in the checklist below must be received by the ASDAR Scholarship Committee Chair by January 5th, 2023 in a **SINGLE PACKAGE**. **Photographs will result in disqualification and should not be included.** Scholarships are judged and awarded without regard to gender, race, color, religion, national origin or disability. All items in the application package must be paper clipped together in the top left hand corner. The application package must not exceed 15 pages. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

CHECKLIST:

- Scholarship Application (this form), typed or handprinted.
- Statement of at least 250 words but not to exceed 750 words, setting forth the applicant’s college and career objectives, typed.
- Original high school transcript. Transcript must indicate class rank, class size, and test scores. Home school students must include transcripts for grade 9-current year. **If the transcript contains a student photograph, the photograph must be obscured.**
- Letters of recommendation. Include at least two, but not to exceed four signed, dated letters of recommendation from persons in authority from the high school applicant is now attending. Letters of recommendation should cover the applicants ability, work habits, integrity, character, potential, and volunteer activities.
- List of extracurricular activities, honors received and scholastic achievements are limited to a maximum of two 8.5” x 11” sheets of paper, single sided.
- Photo copy of United States citizenship: birth certificate, naturalization papers, or information page of U.S. Passport. Cover your photograph if you are submitting a copy of naturalization or passport pages. If listed, black out social security number.
- ASDAR Financial Need form, typed or hand printed. The NSDAR Scholarship Financial Need form, which can be completed on the computer and printed out, may be substituted for the ASDAR Scholarship Financial Need form.
- Mail application package by January 3rd using Priority Mail to ASDAR Scholarship Committee Chair. Keep the tracking number for reference.
